The YLA, formerly known as the Youth Leadership Forum, is a training program held by the Virginia Board for People with Disabilities that seeks to empower youth with disabilities to further develop and demonstrate their leadership skills. Students, serving as Delegates, participate in a wide range of personal, professional, and career development activities, social skills enhancement, small group exploration, and interact with enthusiastic peers and successful role models on the campus of Virginia State University.

Eligibility

- Have a developmental or other disability
- Be a rising high school sophomore, junior, or senior as of December 2019
- Demonstrated leadership potential
- Reside in Virginia
